### The Nature Foundations

Why do we own reserves and land with great nature value? What makes us different?

- Set goals that differ considerably from what other private and public landowners can.
- 100% focus on nature conservation, research and nature interpretation.
- Objectives set apart from earnings and policy goals.
- Generate projects and catalyze processes based on ownership of land or financial support.











## Legislation – opportunities and limitations

Conservation Act for Lille Vildmose (Dec. 2017):

- secure and improve the overall landscape
- ensure favorable conservation status on designated nature habitats and species
- ensure public access
- allow for the release of exterminated indigenous species in order to reestablish a more natural dynamic
- eventually open up the possibility of connecting the three existing fenced areas in one
- ensure the possibility of nature restoration in accordance with the above objectives

- Over-all management plan (Conservation Act) – including objectives for vegetation (invasive species), hydrology, grazing and human-management!


#### Monitoring:
